SELECTION PROCEDURE USED BY WPDSAA

A call for nominations is received by the WP secretary who will then:

- a) Send the call for nominations to all WP Chairmen / Tournaments Officers and the Convener of the Selection Panel. All nominations to be forwarded to the Convener of the Selectors before the closing date.
- b) The Convener of the Selection panel will, on receiving the call for nominations, notify the selectors and set a meeting date, a.s.a.p. after nominations close, for a selectors meeting to grade or select teams
- c) The WP Tournaments Officer will provide the Convener of the Selectors with all league results as they become available.
- d) Relevant team captain's reports must be submitted to the Chairman of WP who will then forward them to the Convener of the Selectors.
- e) Teams will be selected using the WP selection form scoring system in conjunction with relevant team captain's reports.
- f) Once a team has been selected the Convener of the Selectors must advise the WP chairman. It is then the duty of said WP Chairman to notify the anglers selected as well as those that were not within 48 hours. Only the WP chairman may carry out this duty.
- g) The Convener must advise the WP secretary in writing of all teams selected. The WP secretary will advise the host province regarding our team (if any) and the names of team members.

The following criteria will apply for selection to participate at :

- **All Coast / Interprovincial** requires no previous caps. WP League participation in relevant type of fishing is essential.
- **Provincial** as above.
- **Nationals** require two provincial caps
- **SADSAA** requires two national caps
- **Protea** requires two SADSAA caps

The selectors may not divulge any information regarding the deliberations and selection results of any anglers nominated. They may not comment or report on any team captain's report other than during a selection meeting. Selectors should avoid any individual contact or comment regarding the selection process and or selected or not selected anglers. The Convener should attend WP Council and or Exco meetings if possible.

WPDSAA SELECTORS

- At the WPDSAA AGM, 6 selectors will be elected (no more than 2 from any one club) who shall not be active members of the WP executive but shall be active, experienced anglers having competed in a representative capacity at WP provincial level. Notwithstanding the above, it is accepted that the WP chairman is ex officio.
- A quorum shall be any 3 of the 6 elected members.
- This will form an official fully autonomous sub committee of the WPDSAA.
- At the first opportunity after election, the committee will elect one of their members as the official convener of the selection panel.
- Any selector serving on the committee, who has nominated himself/herself or if any of his/her family has nominated, must recuses him/herself from all deliberations concerning that team selection.
- The convener of the selection panel will be ex officio at any official WPDSAA meeting.

PROCEDURE FOR TEAM SELECTIONS

1. The WPDSAA will call for nominations ensuring that the convener of the selection panel is circulated at the same time as the clubs.
2. All duly completed nominations will be submitted by 21:00hrs on the closing date, by the clubs to the convener of the selection panel.
3. The WPDSAA will forward all league results to the convener of the selection panel and ensure that the convener is kept fully up to date at all times.
4. The convener of the selection panel will call a meeting of selectors.
5. The convener of the selection panel will, as soon as possible after the meeting, advise the chairman of the WPDSAA of the team selected together with their contact telephone numbers and addresses.
6. The chairman of the WPDSAA will advise the relevant members within 48hrs of their selection as well as inform those nominees who never made the team.
7. The WPDSAA will advise the host province accordingly.
8. All team captain's reports will be forwarded to the chairman of the WPDSAA who will then forward copies to the convener of the selection panel together with any relevant comments.

SELECTORS DUTIES WILL INCLUDE:

- Compilation and update of the nomination form to form part of the Bye-Laws of the Constitution subject to the approval of council.
- Selection of Association & Provincial teams as well as verification and grading of nominations for National Selection.
- Members of the selection committee may not divulge any names of nominees or any content of deliberations at the selection committee meetings nor may they enter into discussion or correspondence with any nominees.
- Selection of teams will be strictly on merit based on a system approved by council, taking into account passed performance and general fishing ability as well as character and conduct of the nominated angler.
- The selection panel will be expected to make themselves available to assist in any way possible to maintain and elevate the ethics, standards and understanding of Deep Sea Angling and the role of the WPDSAA therein.
