1. Introduction

All Anglers and Skippers from both International and Nationals teams attended the briefing which took place at 16h30. This would be the 3rd time a bottom fish tournament would be fished according to the new SADSAA bottom fish rules which is a catch, measure and release format with 28 species identified for the Anglers to catch. All fish were to be released and only if an Angler was claiming record or updating of their CV were they allowed to bring the fish to the scales. Tournament rules were discussed and weather committee was elected for the Tournament.

4. Parade

All the SADSAA Dignitaries, Teams and Skippers gathered on the harbour wall holding their respective international, national and provincial flags to hold a procession into the venue.





When the parade entered the venue the International, National and Provincial flags were secured into holders placed around the venue.

5. **Opening Function**

The venue for the opening function was stylishly decorated and created an air of a grand affair. The venue's walls are adorned with replica fish species found in South Africa which makes this venue suitable to host such an event. Thanks must go to the organising committee and the staff of Struisbaai Harbour Café for their work to decorate the tables and venue.



The rendering of the national anthems of South Africa, Gibraltar and Iceland were played and sung at the function. Roger Marais the master of ceremonies welcomed the dignitaries, anglers, skippers and non-participating persons. Speeches were giving by the following persons: Andries Maree [South African Sport Angling and Casting Confederation - President], Chris Schorn [South African Deep Sea Angling Association - President], Mr. Paul Swart [Cape Agulhas Municipality - Mayor], DP Burger [Western Province Deep Angling Association - Chairman], Charlie Bear [European Federation of Sport Anglers - Committee Member Gibraltar] and Skarpheoinn Asbjornsson [European Federation of Sport Anglers - Chairman Iceland].

Chris Schorn (SADSAA President) and Nick Nel (SADSAA Tournaments Officer) then began the capping ceremony. It was touching to see how many members of the same family were representing their province or country and the fathers were invited to help their sons or daughters into their blazers for the first time. The Gerber family had three members participating this year. Wayne the dad was in the Barbarian team, Mom, Sheena captained the SADSAA Ladies' team and son Christopher fished in SADSAA Seniors team. John Leuf has had a great influence on his daughter Jacqueline's fishing career and he had the honour to help her into her Protea Blazer.



Special mention was made about Earl Fenwick who received Springbok colours for fishing in 1971 and 1972. He is approaching his 80th birthday but is still actively involved in the fishing fraternity. The dress code insisted that one wear their highest colours and he proudly wore his Springbok blazer.



Once the capping ceremony was completed dinner was served and the party began. Old friends reconnected and a great time was had by all.

6. Competition days

6.1 Day 1: Saturday 27th April 2024




Below is a gallery of photos depicting the launch which went smoothly thanks to the drivers who helped get the boats in the water as quickly as possible.














The captains of all the National teams who did not win medals were called up to receive participation blazer pins.

In the Mens division, Bronze medals were presented to SADSAA Seniors, Silver to Natal and Gold to Border. The angler with the third highest score was Ian Peinke, second was Sayed Cassim and first was Fred Clarke.



The International competition was very close. Bronze went to Gibraltar, Silver to SASACC and Gold to the Protea Men. The International Angler with the third highest points was Protea Lady, Jacqui Luef, second was SASACC's Francois Beukes and first was Protea DP Burger.



The angler with the most meritorious fish was Protea Lady Michelle Richards who caught a 12.25kg yellowtail on 6kg line in the competition and it is a pending SADSAA Ladies record and for her province, Natal.
